## **Abstract Sharpie Drawings on Tin Foil**

**Age Level:** 6+ years (with the help of a grown up)

Time: 30 minutes or less

## Supplies/Materials:

- ☐ Tin Foil
- ☐ Sharpies (variety of colors)
- ☐ Piece of cardboard
- ☐ Washi tape or other tape you might have

## Instructions:

- Start by flattening out the tin foil on to a piece of cardboard
- 2. Tape the sheet along the edges, smooth any bumps or bubbles
- 3. Using a black sharpie marker carefully doodle a loopy line around your paper, overlapping and swirling it around the page. (do not scribble, make controlled lines and loops) \*Make sure to draw slow so you don't poke holes in your foil\*
- 4. You can add flowers or other doodle-y designs.
- 5. After the black marker dries, use colorful sharpies (or other permanent markers) to color in the sections.
- 6. At the end you can add puffy paint patterns and lines for a finishing touch if you choose to.
