

Gig Harbor Sports Field Rules

GH Sports fields players and visitors are expected to follow these Rules. Please make sure your team is aware for full compliance:

1. Respect the property and amenities
2. Respect others and their property
3. This is a weapons free zone, including toy and non-lethal weapons
4. Follow staff directions
5. Follow posted signage and keep all **prohibited** items off the field such as:
 - a. Pets or animals, except service animals allowed by Washington law (RCW 49.60.215; RCW 49.60.040(25)).
 - b. Food, snacks, gum, sunflower seeds
 - c. Sports drinks, energy drinks, soft drinks, coffee, tea, alcohol
 - d. Glass containers
 - e. Tobacco and vaping products
 - f. Fireworks, open flame, propane, and other gas tanks except medically necessary oxygen
 - g. Bicycles, tricycles, unicycles, and similar devices
 - h. Metal cleats, shoe spikes, tent stakes
 - i. Golfing, shot put, javelin, discus
 - j. Drones, model planes, rockets
 - k. Knives, forks, shovels, and other pointed objects
 - l. Motorized vehicles / electric vehicles including scooters and bikes
6. Do not drag the goals, use wheels provided or lift them to move them
7. No climbing on goals or any other stationary objects including goal posts, soccer goals, fences, bleachers, light poles, etc.
8. Children ages 0-14 years old must be supervised by an adult
9. No loud music/speakers/megaphones, microphones
10. No pop-up tents
11. No generators
12. Lights will go off promptly at the time requested. Plan accordingly
13. Small sports cargo wagons are allowed, but must have all terrain wheels
14. Put garbage in the provided garbage cans
15. Don't remove anything from the fields that is not yours
16. Report unlawful activity to the Gig Harbor Police - 911

Note - Doris Heritage Park is owned and operated by the City of Gig Harbor, not the YMCA, and is closed at dusk. Please be sure your children are not in the park after dusk.
